The **Primary Contact** is the registrar or other person responsible for maintaining the marine mammal inventory records for the owner or at the facility. The **Responsible Official** and the **Primary Contact** can be the same person, but should be noted in both Sections II and III.
- 4. Institutional contact data submitted by email, fax, or mail will be entered into the National Inventory of Marine Mammals (NIMM).
- 5. Documentation required for this information collection is subject to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). Personal or sensitive information that is subject to the Privacy Act will be redacted under FOIA.
