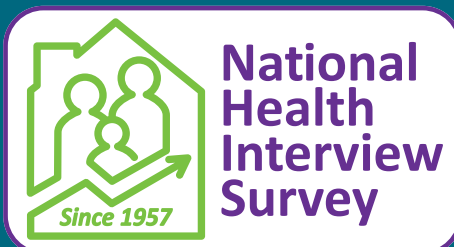

What is the NHIS?

The NHIS is the primary source of information on the nation's health.

As the country's largest in-person household health survey, the NHIS has been taking the pulse of the nation since 1957.

The Trusted Gold Standard

NHIS data are used to:

- Monitor progress towards national health objectives
- Evaluate health policies and programs
- Track changes in health behaviors and health care use

Covers Key Topics of National Importance

- Medical conditions
- Health insurance
- Doctor's office visits
- Physical activity and other health behaviors

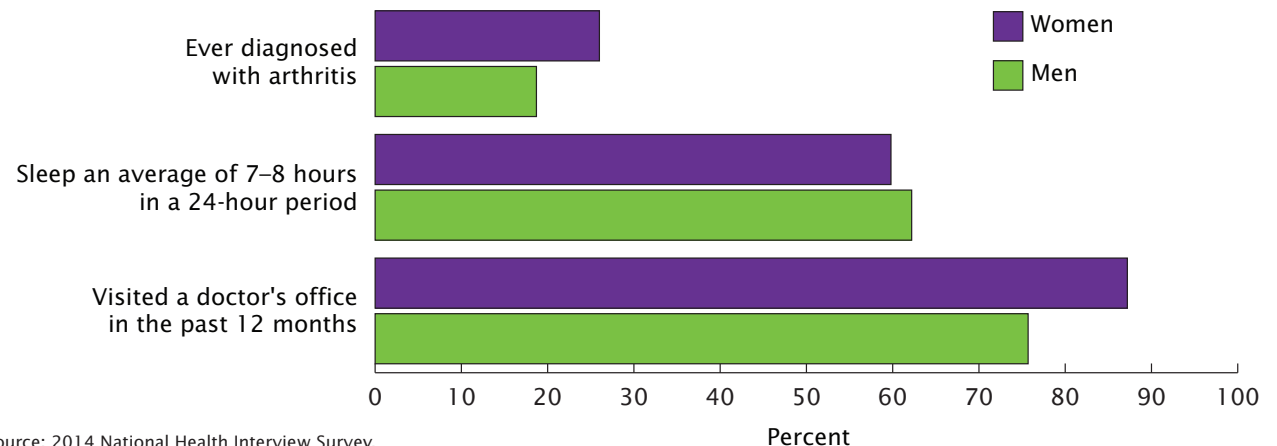
Each Selected Household is Important
