The second reference form may be from a person who can speak to your capabilities and interests as they relate to this scholarship. This may include teaching assistants or an advisor or mentor from a job, volunteer, internship or competition experience related to NOAA's mission. Recommendations from NOAA staff are acceptable if that person served as your mentor during an internship or is a faculty member at your college or university. If the NOAA employee reference is a faculty member then he/she must use a school email account when submitting the reference form. If the NOAA employee served as a mentor, then he/she must use their personal email as a @noaa.gov email account will not be allowed through the application system.
