All accounts requested by individuals are subject to verification and approval by administrators. Users can activate accounts on the website through two different mechanisms: manual registration or an automated process.

Addendum 1: Full text of the terms of service

1. Acceptance of terms

3. Your registration obligations

In consideration of your use of this service, you agree to: (a) provide true, accurate, current and complete information about yourself as prompted by the registration form and (b) maintain and promptly update your information to keep it true, accurate, current and complete. If you provide any information that is untrue, inaccurate, not current or incomplete, or International Exchange Alumni has reasonable grounds to suspect that such information is untrue, inaccurate, not current or incomplete, International Exchange Alumni reserves the right to suspend or terminate your account and refuse any and all current or future use of the International Exchange Alumni site (or any portion thereof).

4. International Exchange Alumni Privacy Policy
