If you do not have information available for 2020, estimates are acceptable for this test. If you are not currently farming, the online questionnaire will take you through a few quick questions then straight to the end. If you’re responding by mail, please make a note on the front of the questionnaire and mail it back to us. We will update our records accordingly. Please respond promptly to avoid follow-up contacts.
