#### PART I.—GENERAL INFORMATION

**Background.**--This proceeding was instituted in response to a petition filed on March 27, 2020, by Worthington Industries, Columbus, Ohio. Countervailing and antidumping duties may be assessed on the subject imports as a result of these proceedings if the Commission makes an affirmative determination of injury, threat, or material retardation, and if the U.S. Department of Commerce ("Commerce") makes an affirmative determination of subsidization and dumping. Questionnaires and other information pertinent to this proceeding are available at https://usitc.gov/investigations/701731/2020/non\_refillable\_steel\_cylinders\_china/final.htm.

Non-refillable steel cylinders covered by these investigations are certain seamed (welded or brazed), non-refillable steel cylinders meeting the requirements of, or produced to meet the requirements of, U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) Specification 39, TransportCanada Specification 39M, or United Nations pressure receptacle standard ISO 11118 and otherwise meeting the description provided below (non-refillable steel cylinders). The subject non-refillable steel cylinders are portable and range from 300-cubic inch (4.9 liter) water capacity to 1,526-cubic inch (25 liter) water capacity. Subject non-refillable steel cylinders may be imported with or without a valve and/or pressure release device and unfilled at the time of importation.

Specifically excluded are seamless nonrefillable steel cylinders.

Non-refillable steel cylinders are currently imported under statistical reporting numbers 7311.00.0060 and 7311.00.0090 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (HTSUS). They may also be imported under HTSUS statistical reporting number 7310.29.0025 and 7310.29.0050. The HTSUS provisions are for convenience and customs purposes; the written description of the scope is dispositive.

Note.— The scope for these final phase investigations has changed and only includes unfilled cylinders. It does not include filled cylinders, as it did during the preliminary phase of the investigations.

**Reporting of information**.--If information is not readily available from your records, provide carefully prepared estimates. If your firm is completing more than one questionnaire (i.e., a producer, importer, and/or purchaser questionnaire), you need not respond to duplicated questions.
