You may not be paid benefits under the Railroad Unemployment Insurance Act for the general benefit year July 1, through June 30, unless you had railroad earnings (not counting over \$1330 for any one month) of at least \$ in : also, if was your first year in railroad work, you must have railroad service in at least five months in .
