

OCPS Deleted Questions from 2018 to 2020

Q1. On November 6, 2018, where was your primary residence? [Single Punch]

Value	Value Label
1	United States/territories
2	Country other than the United States
-99	Refused

- Reason for deletion: The 2020 survey combines Q1 and Q3 of the 2018 survey. Now, it only asks for country of residence on November 3, 2020.

Q12A. Which of the following best describes why you did not vote in the election? [Single Punch]

Value	Value Label
1	I was not registered to vote.
2	I did not know how to get an absentee ballot.
3	My absentee ballot arrived too late.
4	My absentee ballot did not arrive at all.
5	The absentee voting process was too complicated.
6	Some other reason
-99	Refused
-100	Valid Skip

- Reason for deletion: The 2020 survey retains the main reason for not voting question (Q15), which tells us whether the respondent wanted to vote or did not want to vote. Follow-up “reason for not voting” questions were removed.

Q12B. Please specify the primary reason why you did not vote in the November 6, 2018 General Election. [Open End Essay]

- Reason for deletion: This question is a follow-up to the above question.

Q24. Did you access the internet on a cell phone, tablet or other mobile handheld device, at least occasionally, in October 2018? [Single Punch]

Value	Value Label
1	Yes
0	No
-98	Not sure/Don't know
-99	Refused

- Reason for deletion: As it is an online survey, we can reasonably assume that participants had at least occasional Internet access.
