LAND CONTRACT RECAPTURE AGREEMENT

This agreement made this (1) _____ day of (2) _____, (3) _____, is entered into between (4) _____ (hereinafter called "Seller") and the United States of America acting through the Farm Service Agency of the U.S. Department of Agriculture (hereinafter called "Agency"). Agency has paid a loss claim on the Land Contract of the Seller under the Standard Guarantee Plan, copy of which is attached as Attachment A and incorporated hereto. The Seller has chosen the appraisal method of payment rather than liquidation, and is retaining the property after liquidation. This agreement will expire on (5) _____, five years from the date of the loss claim payment.
