

Public Notice of Standard Voluntary Liquidation

Notice must be made for a period of two months in every issue of a newspaper published in the city or town in which the bank is located, or if no newspaper is there, then in the newspaper published nearest to the bank's location.

Example:

Voluntary Liquidation

*Exact Corporate Bank Name
Street Address
City, County, State*

This notice is given pursuant to 12 USC 182 that *(bank name)* is closing its business voluntarily. Notice also has been given to the Comptroller of the Currency, *(address of the district office--street, city, state)*, of its plan to liquidate.

The bank is closing its affairs. Any creditor should present its claim against the bank for payment by *(insert date that is no earlier than 14 calendar days after the date of the final newspaper publication of this notice)* either by mail to *(mailing address)* or in person to *(street address)*.
