Public Notice of Standard Voluntary Liquidation

Notice must be made for a period of two months in every issue of a newspaper published in the city or town in which the bank is located, or if no newspaper is there, then in the newspaper published nearest to the bank's location.

Example:

Voluntary Liquidation

Exact Corporate Bank Name Street Address City, County, State

This notice is given pursuant to 12 USC 182 that (bank name) is closing its business voluntarily. Notice also has been given to the Comptroller of the Currency, (address of the district office--street, city, state), of its plan to liquidate.

The bank is closing its affairs. Any creditor should present its claim against the bank for payment by (insert date that is no earlier than 14 calendar days after the date of the final newspaper publication of this notice) either by mail to (mailing address) or in person to (street address).
