## **PURPOSE:**

The goal of this National Library of Medicine (NLM) survey is to collect qualitative customer service delivery feedback from users of the National Center for Biotechnology Information (NCBI) ClinicalTrials.gov website. NLM will conduct in-person focus group testing to assess the usability and readability of two ClinicalTrials.gov newly revised informational webpages: (1) – "Background" and (2) "Learn About Clinical Studies" pages.
