<b>When must information be submitted to the Coast Guard?</b>	The deadline for submission is 28 February of each year.

<b>What happens when complete information is received?</b>	The CG reviews the information for eligibility and completeness. Applicants meeting the criteria outlined in CSCINST 1780 (series) have all identifying information redacted prior to being reviewed and ranked by the Scholarship Committee.
