

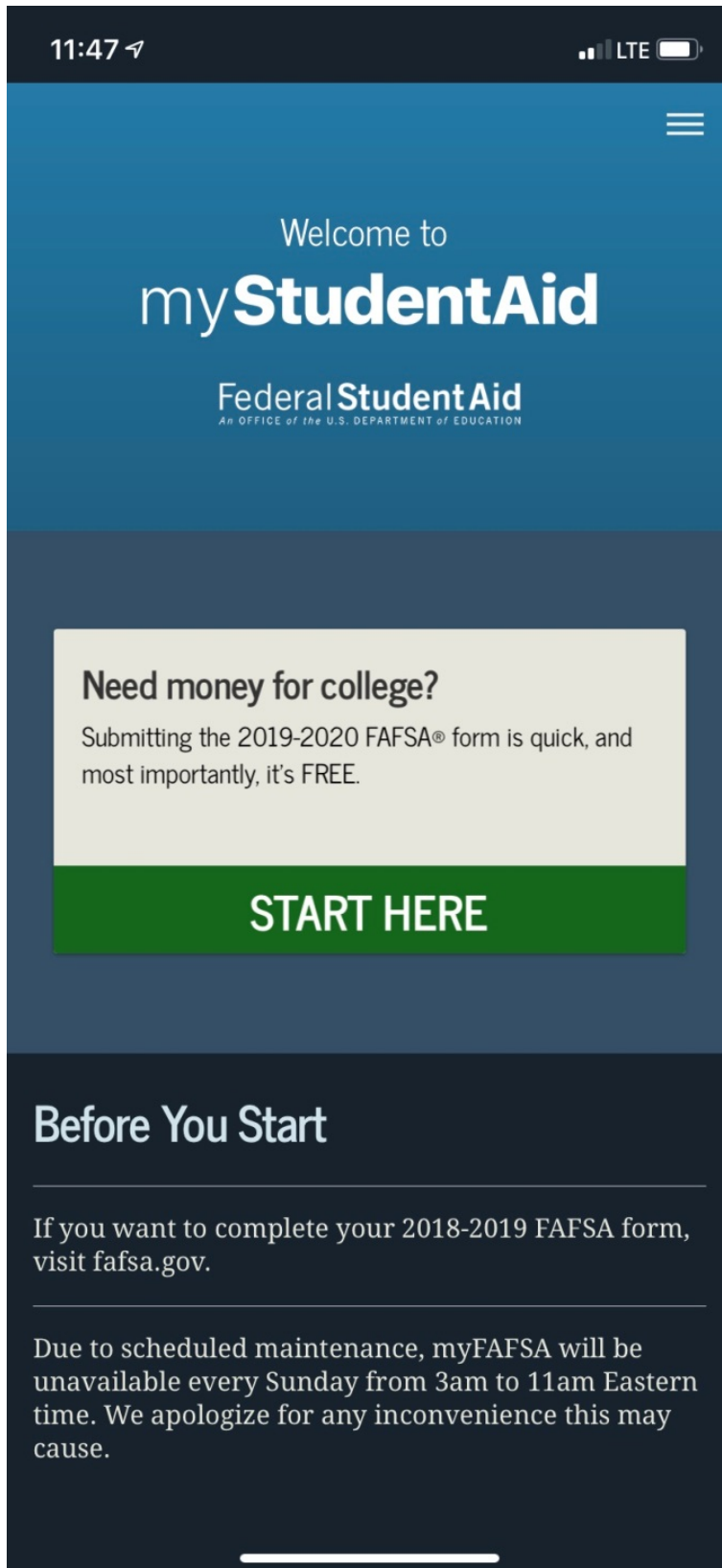

**NEED HELP?**

### Welcome to *FAA Access to CPS Online!*

Use *FAA Access to CPS Online* to:

- View students' SAR information
- Compare two ISIR transactions for the same student
- Submit a signature flag for an application in a signature hold status
- Enter a FAFSA or Renewal FAFSA
- Correct a processed FAFSA
- Continue working on a saved FAFSA or Correction
- Enter Identity Verification Results
- Request ISIR data
- Calculate and manage the return of Title IV funds
