Special Instructions for Loan Repayment Coordinators (LRPC) and Personnel Officials

- ICs must extend employment offers for 2 years for the AIDS and Clinical LRP or 3 years for the General Research LRP.
 Renewal applicants must have an offer of continued employment for one year, to coincide with the LRP contract period. The
 LRP contract commences on the program eligibility date which is the receipt date of an application in the LRP office or the EOD
 date for new hires, whichever occurs later.
- Basic NIH salary entered in Section 2 is as of the applicant's program eligibility date. For applicants employed under the
 Commissioned Corps, salary comprises base pay plus quarters, subsistence, and variable housing allowances. Special and
 bonus pay, such as board-certified, contract, and variable incentive pay, are not included. Similarly, for applicants under the
 General Schedule pay plan, Physicians Comparability Allowances (PCA) are not included in the salary calculation. However,
 pursuant to 5 CFR § 595.105(e), an individual receiving a PCA who is accepted into the LRP must have his/her PCA reduced
 by the amount of the loan repayment upon entry to the LRP.
