## INTRODUCTION

- **New! 30** are newly proposed additions made to the 30-day package.
- **Revised! 30** have proposed changes to already existing categories, and were revised prior to the 30 day comment period based on feedback from the 60 day comment period and/or technical edits and corrections.
- **Revised! 60** were revised prior to the 60 day comment period.
- **Retired!** are no longer being collected in SYs 2017-18 and 2018-19, under the ESEA, as amended by ESSA.
- **Final!** have been revised in the final package in response to the 30 day public comment feedback received and decisions not to implement ESSA regulations.
- **Revised TA!** changes made as part of technical amendments.

**Age (Early Childhood)** is defined as “the discrete age of children (students) who are in early childhood on the state specified child count date.”

**Age (School Age)** is defined as “the discrete age of children (students) who are school age on the state specified child count date.”

**Age (Exiting)** is defined as “the discrete age of children (students) on the date of the most recent IDEA child count prior to exiting special education.”

**Age Group** is defined as “the age range of students (children).”

**Age (PK)** is defined as “the age ranges of children who are younger than age 5.”
