Any information provided about IMS/PIC is only due to that being the system the data is submitted into.

The forms HUD-50058, HUD-50058 MTW, and HUD-50058 MTW Expansion Family Reports solicit demographic, family profile, income and housing information on the entire nationwide population participating in the public housing and voucher programs. This information is utilized for the subsequent purposes:

- Analyze public housing and housing choice voucher programs;
- Permit PHAs to monitor their own reporting to identify favorable and unfavorable trends;
- Monitor PHAs and participants for compliance with program regulations and requirements;
- Fraud detection and prevention via rent/income monitoring;
- Housing inventory and development of program initiatives with emphasis on the housing of special needs group; and
- Make available accurate demographic information depicting tenant characteristics to Congress and other interested parties.

The last update to the HUD-50058 and HUD-50058 MTW occurred in 2013. In 2016 the forms were renewed by OMB with no changes. There are no changes to those forms in this PRA request. There is no change to the burden hours since the 100 agencies that will cease to submit the HUD-50058, which is part of this information collection, that they currently utilize and will instead submit the HUD-50058 MTW Expansion.
