To be eligible for the Veteran Rapid Retraining Assistance Program (VRRAP), you must meet all the requirements listed here.

- Between 22 and 66 years old,
- Unemployed because of the COVID-19 pandemic,
- Not eligible for GI Bill or VR&E benefits (or, if you're eligible for the Post-9/11 GI Bill, you've transferred your benefits to a family members),
- Not rated as totally disabled because you can't work,
- Not enrolled in a federal or state jobs programs,
- Not receiving unemployment or CARES Act benefits.
