

XI. NWOS Wildfire Science Module

Wildfire is an unplanned fire that starts in forestland, woodland, or rangeland. It can be started by lightning or by people, either accidentally or intentionally.

Prescribed fire is a burn set by professionals on forestland, woodland, or rangeland under strict guidelines. Prescribed fire is used to prevent build-ups of flammable woody materials that could cause intense wildfires.
