Purpose: NMFS requests information from fish buyers and sellers to ensure accurate management and repayment of buyback loans.

Routine Uses: NMFS will enforce the collection of all fee payments and bring legal actions for collection enforcement against any fish seller or fish buyer who fails to pay, collect, deposit, and/or disburse the fee in accordance with the regulations. NMFS will audit ex-vessel landing records and fish buyer records for the purpose of determining and enforcing compliance. NMFS will use this information to determine compliance with §§ 600.1000-600.1017. Disclosure of this information is permitted under the Privacy Act of 1974 (5 U.S.C. Section 552a), to be shared within NMFS' Financial Services Division.
