NMFS will audit ex-vessel landing records and fish buyer records for the purpose of determining and enforcing compliance. NMFS will use this information to determine compliance with §§ 600.1000-600.1017. Disclosure of this information is permitted under the Privacy Act of 1974 (5 U.S.C.
