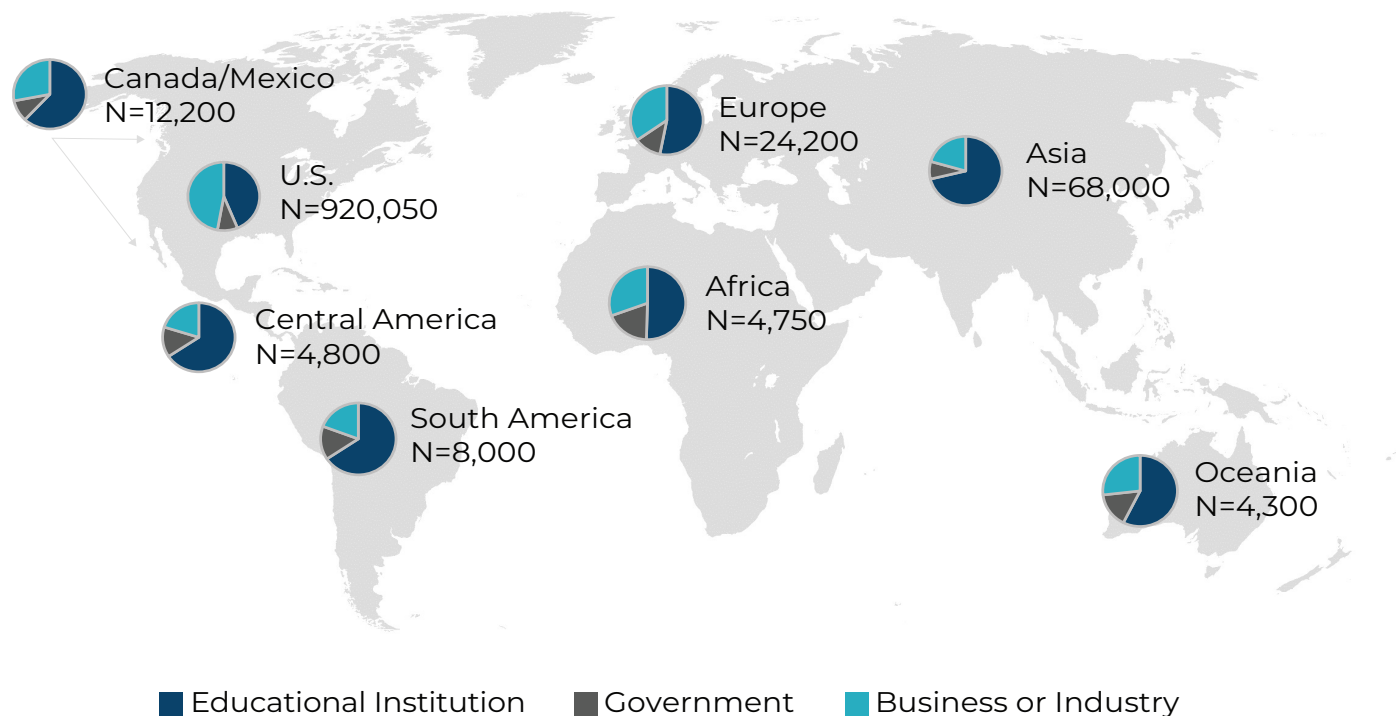

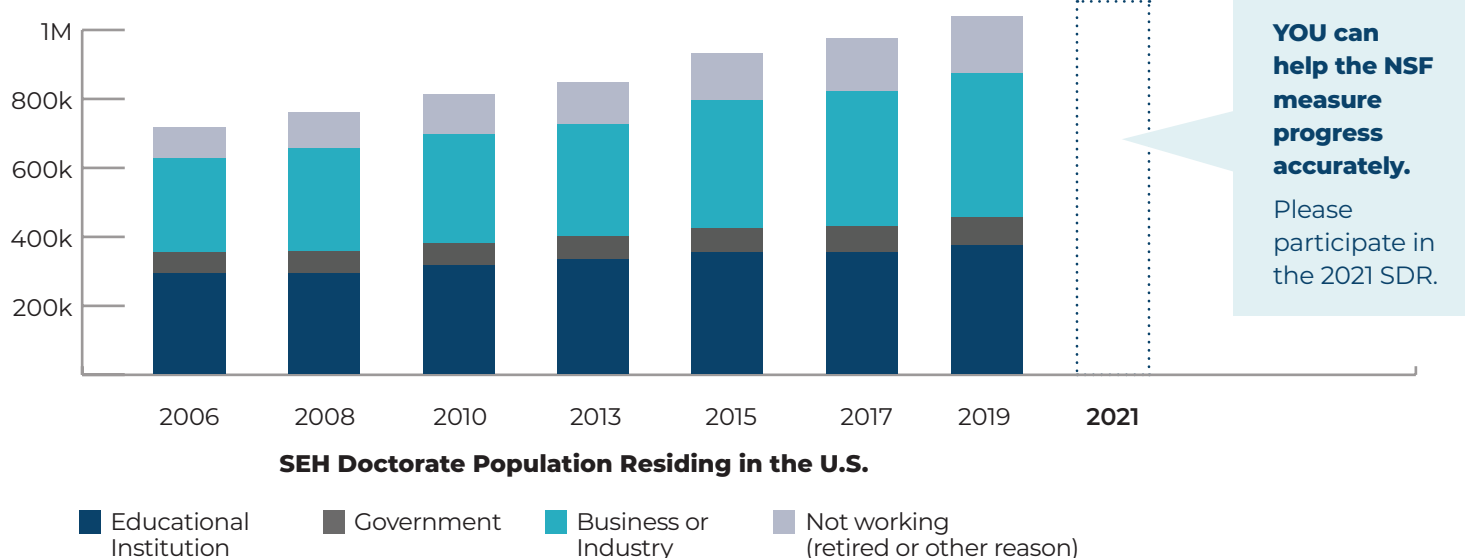
# U.S.–Trained Science, Engineering, and Health Research Doctorate Holders: Global Reach in Diverse Sectors
