

Instrument 9: Action Planning Form

A Breakthrough Series Collaborative for Engaging Fathers and Paternal Relatives in Child Welfare

The purpose of the information collection is to help improvement teams document goals for their efforts during each of the three action periods in this BSC.

This information will help the FCL project team identify which efforts were most successful for improving engagement of fathers and paternal relatives. Guidance for using this form will be described in more detail at the learning sessions.
