The Application for Replacement Naturalization/Citizenship Document (N-565) is used to apply to U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCS) for a replacement of a Certificate of Instanziazation, Certificate of Citizenship, Declaration Comments, Repartations Certificate, or to apply far a special certificate of Citizenship Certification (Inneres). Replantation Certificate, or to apply far a special certificate of naturalization to be recognized as a U.S. Citizen by a foreign country.

Before You Start Your Application

Eligibility

- You may apply for a replacement document if:
- You were issued a Certificate of Naturalization, Certificate of Citizenship, Declaration of Intention, or Repatriation Certificate which was loof, stolen, destroyed, or mutilated

- You were issued a Certificate of Ciracenship, a Certificate of Naturalization, Declaration of Indentina, or Repulsiation Certificate and you change of gender is legally recognised through a court office, a government-issued document, er a letter from a Ecensed health care professional.
 You are a naturalized others residing a special certificate of naturalization for the purpose of a foreign country recognizing you as a citizen of the United States.

NOTE: USCIS will not change your name without evidence such as a marriage certificate, diverce decree, or court order.

USCIS carrolt make any changes to an incorrect date of birth or name on a Cestificate of Naturalization if you provided an incorrect date or name on your Applications for Naturalization (No.D), and these lates move to the facts of your application by signing Part 16, Signature at laterview.
