



National Fire Department Registry



- Formerly called the National Fire Department Census.
- Established in 2001 by the U.S. Fire Administration (USFA).
- Provides a current directory of registered fire departments.
- Includes basic information, such as address, department type, number of personnel, number of stations, etc.
- The purpose of the registry is to create a national database for use by the fire service and its stakeholders.
- Over 27,000 fire departments are registered.
