Submission Requirements

If the borrower submitted a loan forgiveness application to its PPP lender before December 27, 2020, then this form must be completed and submitted to your PPP Lender not later than January 26, 2021. If your PPP lender has already submitted a forgiveness decision to SBA, the PPP lender must promptly transmit the completed SBA Form 3508D to SBA via email at pppforgivenessrequests@sba.gov. Otherwise, your PPP lender must transmit the completed SBA Form 3508D to SBA via the Paycheck Protection Platform when the PPP lender issues its forgiveness decision to SBA. If the borrower submits a loan forgiveness application to its PPP lender on or after December 27, 2020, this form must be completed and submitted to your PPP Lender within 30 days after submitting the forgiveness application. In that case, your PPP lender must transmit the completed SBA Form 3508D to SBA via the Paycheck Protection Platform when the PPP lender issues its forgiveness decision to SBA. Alternatively, PPP lenders may transmit the completed Form 3508D to SBA when received via email to pppforgivenessrequests@sba.gov. A borrower that submits SBA Form 3508S directly using the Paycheck Protection Platform must upload this form to the Paycheck Protection Platform within 30 days of submission of its forgiveness application.

Privacy Act (5 U.S.C. 552) – The information provided in this form is protected by the Privacy Act, 5 U.S.C 552a, which prohibits the federal government from disclosing personal information about an individual without the individual's consent. The Privacy Act authorizes SBA to make certain routine uses of information protected by the Act as set forth in its System of Records Notice. See 74 F.R. 14890 (2009). One such routine use is the disclosure of information maintained in SBA's system of records when this information indicates a violation or potential violation of law, whether civil, criminal, or administrative in nature. Specifically, SBA may refer the information to the appropriate agency, whether Federal, State, local or foreign, charged with responsibility for, or otherwise involved in investigation, prosecution, enforcement or prevention of such violations. Proprietary data on a borrower would not routinely be made available to third parties.
