During the extension period for the *Feeding My Baby Study*, WIC State agencies will be asked to provide administrative data for study participants who left the study before the study child's fifth birthday from a list provided by Westat in a one-time request.

Westat Role and Responsibilities:

- Westat will provide access to its secure file-transfer (sFTP) website to the designated staff from the state agency.
- Westat will securely transmit an Excel spreadsheet with the information below as available for each participant:
 - a. Caregiver Name
 - b. Caregiver Date of Birth
 - c. Caregiver WIC ID
 - d. Child's Name
 - e. Child's Date of Birth
 - f. Child's WIC ID
 - **g.** Name and State of the WIC clinic at which the participant enrolled in the study
 - **h.** Last known clinic at which the participant was receiving services
 - i. Caregiver's address
 - **j.** Caregiver's phone number(s)
 - k. Caregiver's email address
 - I. Start date of the reference period
 - **m.** End date of the reference period
 - **n.** Blank columns for the State to enter dates during which the participant started and stopped receiving WIC benefits.
