 _ Signed invoice with statement "No other form of compensation has been received."
 Autopsy protocol must include:heart and lung description and weightsheart valve measurementsheart ventricular measurementspathological diagnosiscause of death (optional on partial autopsies)clinical summarymicroscopic examinationage, height, and weight
 _ Radiograph (PA) and interpretation made within 5 years
