TITLE OF INFORMATION COLLECTION: BPCA Framework Initiative Resource Collection

PURPOSE: As part of the BPCA mandate, six public assemblies have been convened to develop a generic framework to provide an overall structure to enable pediatric drug development studies. The goal is to develop -- in collaboration with subject matter experts (SMEs) in pediatric care and research -- an annotated, selective, curated collection of resources that will assist drug developers, researchers, and clinicians conducting pediatric drug development research. As part of this process, assembly participants are asked to submit references for best practice and guidance documents for inclusion in the final framework. An online form has been created in Survey Monkey to streamline this process.

DESCRIPTION OF RESPONDENTS: Respondents are members of the public who have participated in one or more of six public assemblies in the following subject areas: biomarkers, pediatric-friendly formulations, systems pharmacology, PK modeling to inform dosing, advancing clinical trial design, and pharmacoepidemiology. Respondents are primarily pediatricians and researchers who work in academia, industry, and regulatory settings. Thus far, there have been an average of approximately 50 participants on each assembly call who would potentially respond to this survey. Participants may respond to the survey as many times as they would like. We anticipate an average of two responses per participant.
