Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Consumer Price Index (CPI)?

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) is a measure of change in the cost of goods and services typically purchased by urban consumers. As the only comprehensive measure of inflation at the retail level, the CPI is widely used by private industry, labor unions, and the federal government to help in making informed business and economic decisions. Below are a few examples of uses of the CPI:

- The cost-of-living adjustments for over 50 million Social Security beneficiaries.
- The cost of lunches for millions of school children.
- Federal income tax brackets, so you don't pay higher taxes because of inflation.
- Payments in collective bargaining agreements.

Why are you verifying my information?

The Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) regularly conducts verifications on the accuracy of the data collected by its staff as part of a legally mandated quality assurance process. This contact is part of that quality assurance process, and your response will help the BLS provide accurate statistics.

What will you do with my information / Is this confidential?
