Application To Extend/Change Nonimmigrant Status



Currently, you may file an Application to Extend/Change Nonimmigrant Status (I-539) online if you are filing for yourself.

You should refer to Instructions for Form I-539 to see if you can use this online form for your nonimmigrant status.



You can file an individual request online only for certain statuses.

At this time, you cannot file online if you:

- Have additional applicants
- · Have an A, G, NATO or V nonimmigrant status

You will need to file a paper Form I-539.




Eligibility

You may be eligible to apply for an extension of your authorized stay if:

- You were lawfully admitted into the United States with a nonimmigrant visa
- Your nonimmigrant visa status remains valid














I-539: Review and Submit – Review your application (without hard stop)












Copies of any documents I have submitted are exact photocopies of unaltered, original documents, and I understand that USCIS may require that I submit original documents to USCIS at a later date.

Furthermore, I authorize the release of any information from any and all of my records that USCIS may need to determine my eligibility for the immigration benefit that I seek.


