

Other uses include measuring inflation, as an input to fiscal and monetary policy and forecasting future prices. Together with the Consumer Price Indexes and Producer Price Indexes, the International Price Program is considered one of the BLS' three major price programs. These three price programs have been designated as leading Federal economic indicators and are designed to cover the entire U.S. economy.


Review Item Price Factors modal window




Review Cost of Modification screen




Replace Item modal window, 4 collapsible sections











No Replacement Confirmation modal window
