



APPLICATION DEADLINES, To receive approval of your application as quickly as possible, you should submit the completed application not later than 12:00 p.m. EDT on January X, 2021. Applications received after 12:00 p.m. EDT on January X, 2021 will be considered, but may not receive approval as quickly. Applications received after 11:59 p.m. EDT on January Y, 2021, may not be considered, but the Secretary of the Treasury may, in her discretion and subject to the availability of funds, consider such applications for approval.


NOTE FOR AFFILLIATED ENTITIES. Each legal entity eligible to receive PSP2 financial assistance must complete a separate application. However, multiple eligible entities who are approved for PSP2 and who are affiliates under common ownership may enter into a single, consolidated PSP2 Agreement with Treasury covering all the affiliates. The last section of the application will allow members of a corporate family to notify the Treasury that they would like to enter into a consolidated PSP2 Agreement.

Begin a PSP 2 Application



You must be an eligible Passenger Air Carrier or an eligible Contractor to apply for PSP2.

An eligible Passenger Air Carrier means an air carrier that, during the period from April 1, 2019, to September 30, 2019, derived more than 50 percent of its air transportation revenue from the transportation of passengers

An eligible Contractor means:

1) a person that performs, under contract with a passenger air carrier conducting operations under 14 CFR part 121: a) catering functions; or

b) functions on the property of an airport that are directly related to the air transportation of persons, property, or mail, including, but not limited to, the loading and unloading of property on aircraft; assistance to passengers under 14 CFR part 382; security; airport ticketing and check-in functions; ground-handling of aircraft; or aircraft cleaning and sanitization functions and waste removal; or

2) a subcontractor that performs such functions.

No other types of entities are eligible for PSP2 financial assistance.

PSP1 Participants. If you participated in PSP1, you will need to validate certain information you previously provided to the Treasury as part of your PSP1 application.

New Passenger Air Carriers. If you are a Passenger Air Carrier and you did not participate in PSP1, you will need to provide the following information to validate your identity and eligibility:

- 1) Tax ID
- 2) DUNS number
- 3) Your FAA Certificate Number to validate your eligibility. If you do not have an FAA Certificate Number, you are not eligible to apply.

New Contractors. If you are a Contractor and you did not participate in PSP1, you will need to provide the following information to validate your identity and eligibility:

- 1) Tax ID
- 2) DUNS number
- 3) The name of at least one Part 121 Passenger Air Carrier to whom you provide services as a contractor or subcontract.
- 4) A copy of a current contract or subcontract demonstrating that you provide services to a Part 121 Passenger Air Carrier.
- 5) If you provide services other than catering, the name of at least one airport on whose property you provide the services to a Part 121 Passenger Air Carrier as a contractor or subcontractor.
- 6) Copies of your IRS Form 941 "Employer's Quarterly Federal Tax Return" for the October-December 2019 quarter and the January-March 2020 quarter.

Affiliate

Affiliate means any Person that directly or indirectly controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with, the Recipient. For purposes of this definition, "control" of a Person shall mean having the power, directly or indirectly, to direct or cause the direction of the management and policies of such Person, whether by ownership of voting equity, by contract, or otherwise.

The terms defined below are used in various parts of the application. Please take time to review these definitions, and refer back to this section as necessary to complete your

Air Carrier

Air carrier has the meaning given to such term under 49 U.S.C. § 40102.

Awardable amount

Awardable amount means the amount of financial assistance Treasury determines an applicant is eligible to receive under PSP2, prior to any pro rata reduction in accordance with the PSP Extension Law.

Benefits

Benefits means, without duplication of any amounts counted as salary or wages, pension expenses in respect of employees, all expenses for accident, sickness, hospital, and death benefits to employees, and the cost of insurance to provide such benefits; any severance pay or other benefits payable to employees pursuant to a bona fide voluntary early retirement program or voluntary furlough; and any other similar expenses paid by a passenger air carrier or contractor for the benefit of employees, including any other fringe benefit expense described in lines 10 and 11 of Financial Reporting Schedule P-6, Form 41, as published by the Department of Transportation, but excluding any Federal, state, or local payroll taxes paid by a passenger air carrier or contractor.

Catering functions

Catering functions means the preparation, assembly, or both, of food, beverages, provisions, and related supplies for delivery, and the delivery of such items, directly to aircraft or to a location on or near airport property for subsequent delivery to aircraft.



Step 4b: Definitions (2/3)

Contractor

Contractor means:

1) a person that performs, under contract with a passenger air carrier conducting operations

under 14 CFR part 121:

a) catering functions; or

b) functions on the property of an airport that are directly related to the air transportation of persons, property, or mail, including, but not limited to, the loading and unloading of property on aircraft; assistance to passengers under 14 CFR part 382; security; airport ticketing and check-in functions; ground-handling of aircraft; or aircraft cleaning and sanitization functions and waste removal; or 2) a subcontractor that performs such functions.

Corporate officer

Corporate officer means, with respect to a passenger air carrier or contractor, a president; any vice president in charge of a principal business unit, division, or function (such as sales, administration or finance); any other officer who performs a policy-making function; or any other person who performs similar policy-making functions for the passenger air carrier or contractor. Executive officers of subsidiaries or parents of a passenger air carrier or contractor may be deemed corporate officers of the passenger air carrier or contractor.

Employee

Employee means an individual who is employed by an air carrier or a contractor and whose principal place of employment is in the United States (including its territories and possessions), including salaried, hourly, full-time, part-time, temporary, and leased employees, but excluding any individual who is a corporate officer or independent contractor.

Involuntary termination or furlough

Involuntary termination or furlough means a passenger air carrier or contractor terminating the employment of one or more employees or requiring one or more employees to take a temporary suspension or unpaid leave for any reason, including a shut-down or slow-down of business; provided, however, that an involuntary termination or furlough does not include a permitted termination or furlough.

Part 121 Passenger Air Carrier

Part 121 Passenger Air Carrier refers to a passenger air carrier conducting operations under 14 CFR part 121.

Passenger air carrier

Passenger air carrier means an air carrier that, during the period from April 1, 2019, to September 30, 2019, derived more than 50 percent of its air transportation revenue from the transportation of passengers.

Permitted termination or furlough

Permitted termination or furlough means, with respect to an employee, (1) a voluntary furlough, voluntary leave of absence, voluntary resignation, or voluntary retirement; (2) termination of employment resulting from such employee's death or disability; or (3) a passenger air carrier or contractor terminating the employment of such employee for cause or placing such employee on a temporary suspension or unpaid leave of absence for disciplinary reasons, in either case, as reasonably determined by the passenger air carrier or contractor acting in good faith.



Step 4b: Definitions (3/3)

Recall

Recall means the dispatch of a notice by a passenger air carrier or contractor, via mail, courier, or electronic mail, to an involuntarily terminated or furloughed employee notifying the employee that:

- 1) the employee must, within a specified period of time, elect either:
- a) to return to employment or bypass return to employment, in accordance with an applicable collective bargaining agreement or, in the absence of a collective bargaining agreement, company policy; or
- b) to permanently separate from employment with the passenger air carrier or contractor; and
- 2) failure to respond within such time period specified shall be considered an election to permanently separate from employment with the passenger air carrier or contractor.

Returning employee

Returning employee means an involuntarily terminated or furloughed employee who has elected to return to employment pursuant to a recall notice.

Wage

Wage means, without duplication of any amounts counted as benefits, a payment, typically paid on an hourly, daily, or piecework basis, including cost-of-living differentials, vacation, paid time off, sick leave, and overtime pay, paid by a passenger air carrier or contractor to its employees, but excluding any Federal, state, or local payroll taxes paid by the passenger air carrier or contractor.

Salary

Salary means, without duplication of any amounts counted as benefits, a predetermined regular payment, typically paid on a weekly or less frequent basis but which may be expressed as an hourly, weekly, annual or other rate, as well as cost-of-living differentials, vacation time, paid time off, sick leave, and overtime pay, paid by a passenger air carrier or contractor to its employees, but excluding any Federal, state, or local payroll taxes paid by the passenger air carrier or contractor.
