- 2. Applicants are required to furnish, in the manner and detail prescribed in 27 CFR Part 19, the following information:
 - Statement of business organization and of the persons interested in the business, supported by the corporate documents, articles of partnership, and/or statement of interest in the business, as required by 27 CFR Part 19. (Where any statement or document required by this paragraph is on file with the Director, NRC, such statement or document may, by incorporation by reference thereto by the applicant, be made part of the application for an operating permit.)
 - List of the trade names to be used in connection with the operations specified in the application, showing the operation or operations in which each trade name will be used.
