Work Environment

Timing of most traumatic work related event

Type of traumatic work related event

- History of traumatic work related events
- If the decedent was ever encouraged, recommended, or connected with their Employee Assistance Program, wellness systems, or other work-provided mental health supports/resources
- History of disciplinary action at work

Work-related stressors

- History of the decedent's exposure to or participation in any officer-involved shootings
- Shift-work related stress
- Psychological stress of work
- Impact of racism within public safety agencies and communities
- Work related discrimination
- Civil unrest around police misconduct and brutality
- Work-related partner stress
- Death of work partner/colleague
- Witness to death of colleague
- Trouble with a colleague or supervisor
- Poor performance evaluation
- Not getting promoted
- Internal Affairs investigation
- Other (specify below)

Injury Details

Detail about where fatal injury occurred

- Work/service vehicle
- Work site (e.g., Firehouse, police department)
- Training site (police academy, fire academy)
- Military installation/post
- Dispatch location (responding to a call)
- In the field (includes both dispatched & non-dispatched)
- Other (specify below)

- Injury occurred on duty versus outside of duty hours
