### Why is ATSDR testing blood?

- ✓ The soil in Jasper County has high lead levels from historic mining, milling, and smelting.
- ✓ People may have contact with lead in the soil, especially children who play outdoors or in the dirt.
- ✓ Children and pregnant women in Jasper County who have had contact with lead are at a higher risk for health problems.
- ✓ Since lead is found in other sources, ATSDR will review other indoor and outdoor samples collected by state and federal partners.
- ✓ Testing will identify vulnerable people, like young children and pregnant women, whose blood lead levels are high enough to require follow-up with a doctor, as well as potential sources of lead.

- EPA will conduct **FREE** soil and private well drinking water sampling for lead.
- Each participant will receive a \$20 gift card.
- We will send the private results to each participant.
