Call for Abstracts

I. Scientific Abstract: Each partnership (U54 and P20) is required to submit a **Scientific Abstract** describing one (1) original research project. The Scientific Abstract should highlight novel scientific findings from trainees, career development awardees, and PACHE investigators. Topics may be from basic, translational, behavioral, population, and/or clinical research. Those with selected Scientific Abstracts will present a poster during the **Poster Session on July 15**, **2020**. More than one abstract for a scientific poster may be submitted. Please visit the website for submission instructions.

II. Program Abstract: Each partnership (U54 and P20) is required to submit a Program Abstract, which will be printed in the program meeting book to be shared with all attendees for dissemination of information about the partnerships. These abstracts will not be presented as posters. The Program Abstracts will provide more information about the goals and objectives of each partnership.
