Awardees are encouraged, but not required, to present their research activities at the symposium as an oral presentation or poster (must be an awardee).

Oral Presentations

Due to the limited number of slots available for oral presentations, speaker preference will be given to those who have not spoken at the symposium before and have awards nearing completion. In addition, speaker selection will seek programmatic balance across science areas and award types. Speaker selections will be made by May 1, 2020, and speakers notified via email. Oral presentations will be 15 minutes plus 5 minutes for questions and answers.

Space is available for up to 100 posters. If the number of poster abstracts exceeds the number of poster boards available, posters will be selected on a "first-come" basis. Poster selections will be made by May 1, 2020, and presenters notified via email. Posters will be presented on 4' x 6' boards.
