

Title: Trans-NIH Workshop on Sickle Cell Disease Pain To Be Held July 21–22

A trans-National Institutes of Health (NIH) virtual workshop, “Optimizing Therapies for Pain Relief in People With Sickle Cell Disease,” will be held on **Wednesday, July 21 and Thursday, July 22.**

At the workshop, researchers will explore critical gaps and research challenges for sickle cell pain research. They will also brainstorm potential solutions for this understudied pain condition, which affects a highly underserved population. This topic fits into the NIH mission of seeking fundamental knowledge to enhance health.
