* Other Authors with Affiliation Number: If authors have different affiliations, use a number (e.g., 1, 2, 3) before each name to indicate each unique affiliation and then repeat the number in the Other Author Affiliations Textbox

* Other Author Affiliations, City, and State (With matching numbers to the above Other Authors)

* Abstract Body: This should be a written description with a **maximum** of 300 words and should only include plain text with no additional information (ex. symbols, graphs, charts, pictures, etc.).

How to make posters/resize them for Gather Town

Gather Town requires both a Poster and a Poster Preview.

Please follow the directions below to submit.

If you are not able to submit your Poster today, the registration confirmation email will provide instructions on how to return and add this to your registration.

Please note that the poster and poster preview must be uploaded by **February 10, 2022**.

For the Main Poster:

1. We recommend using PowerPoint.
2. Select the Design tab
3. Select the Slide Size icon and choose Custom Slide Size from the dropdown menu
4. Change width to 25 in X 16.667 in
5. A pop-up will appear prompting you to make a selection. Choose Ensure Fit.
6. File > Save. Name appropriately and save as JPG.
7. Upload JPG below
