Potential Sample Topics for the Policy Impact Survey (FR 3075; OMB No. 7100-0362)

The FR 3075 allows the Board to collect information regarding the impact of potential changes in regulation. The principal value of the FR 3075 is the flexibility it provides the Board to participate in multilateral data collection efforts related to rapidly evolving economic developments and global financial stability. Because these initiatives are often urgent and reflect the most current policy variants being considered, the number, type, and content of specific data items cannot be predicted far in advance.

Written qualitative questions or questionnaires may include categorical questions, yes-no questions, ordinal questions, and open-ended questions. Written quantitative surveys may request dollar amounts, percentages, numbers of items, interest rates, and other similar information. In soliciting participation, the Board explains to respondents the purpose of the survey and how the data would be used. Following a survey, the Board makes each survey instrument publicly available on the Board's OMB Public Docket. Potential Sample Topics
