## What will data from this survey be used for?

Your information is important, as it will help evaluate the impact that feral swine or wild hogs have to livestock operations across the country.

The information you provide will be used for statistical purposes only. In accordance with federal law, your responses will be kept confidential and will not be disclosed in identifiable form. APHIS will analyze these data as a baseline for future studies and any published information will be made available to the public by the APHIS' National Wildlife Research Center.
