# Request for a Non-Substantive Change to an Existing Approved Information Collection

(EPA ICR No. 0152.14; OMB Control No. 2070-0020)

## I. Introduction

### Why is EPA Requesting a Non-Substantive Change?

EPA is requesting a non-substantive change to the currently approved ICR, *Notice of Arrival of Pesticide Devices under Section 17(c) of FIFRA*. An outdated version of EPA form 3540-1 (Attachment E) was incorrectly submitted for review and approved by OMB.

## **II. Description of Non-Substantive Changes**

#### What Information Collection Request (ICR) is EPA changing?

ICR Title: Notice of Arrival of Pesticide Devices under section 17(c) of FIFRA

ICR Numbers: EPA ICR No. 0152.14; OMB Control No. 2070-0212

#### What is the current status of this ICR?

This ICR is currently approved through January 31, 2025.

#### What are the changes that EPA is making to this collection of information?

As described in the OMB approved ICR supporting statement on January 20, 2022, (pages 9-15), below is a summary of the changes that were made to **EPA Form 3540-1**:

- 1. Relabeling titled sections 1-3, 6, 8-10, and 12-13
- 2. Incorporation of CFR in section18b and 18c
- 3. Additional box option in PART 2 for Customs and Border Protection (Request CBP to collect samples (19 CFR 4012.116))
- 4. Revision of instructions for Importer of Record or Licensed Customs Broker
- 5. Revision of EPA Form 3540-1 instructions on Page 4
- 6. Revision of Contact Title, "Pesticide Imports Coordinator" and updated address information for EPA Regions (Regions 3, 4, 6, 7, and 10)

#### Will this change impact the annual ICR burden estimates?

No, the current ICR annual burden will not change.
