- Spouses of military members separated from active duty, National Guard and Reserve Components for less than 365 days
- Surviving spouses of military members who died while on active duty

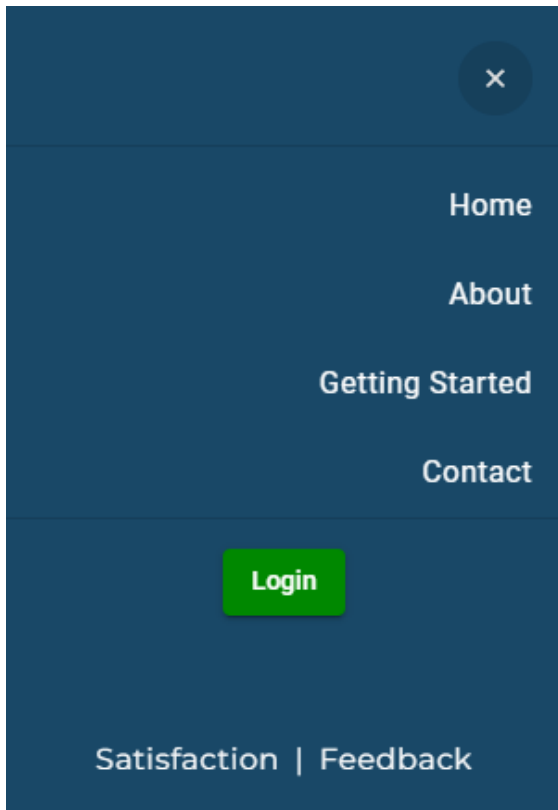

### Military spouses must meet the following eligibility criteria to participate in the SECO program:

- You are a spouse of an active duty, National Guard or reserve component military member in the Army, Marine Corps, Navy, Air Force or Space Force
- You are a spouse of a military member separated from active duty, National Guard and reserves for less than 365 days.
- You are a surviving spouse of a military member who died while on active duty.
- You are not an active-duty military member.
- You are not a spouse of a Coast Guard military member.





As part of your SECO registration, you will also receive your eligibility status for the My Career Advancement Account Scholarship program at the end of registration. MyCAA is a workforce development program that provides up to \$4,000 of financial assistance to eligible military spouses who are pursuing a license, certification or associate degree in a career field and occupation.

By proceeding, you certify that you are eligible for the SECO program.
