


- You are a surviving spouse of a military member who died while on active duty.
- · You are not an active-duty military member.
- You are not a spouse of a Coast Guard military member.






Mil-Spouse Registration Profile Information (Step 1 of 3)




Mil-Spouse Registration Profile Information (Step 2 of 3)




Mil-Spouse Registration Congratulations Page (Step 3 of 3) End of Registration




