Any co-educational institution of higher education that participates in a federal student aid program must prepare an EADA Report by December 31. Institutions must also report data to the U.S. Department of Education via this online survey. This is a mandatory survey.

Data collected in this survey will be published by the Office of Postsecondary Education on the Equity in Athletics Data Analysis Cutting Tool website located at http://ope.ed.gov/lathletics.



Please read this before you begin...

The EADA Survey is not an accounting report. It collects data about revenues and expenses that are similar to data from an income and expense statement. You should not include information about capital assets and related debts. When reporting revenues from institutional support include budgeted dollars that were not spent only if those dollars remained in the athletic department's or team's budget at the end of the year. For example, if a sport is budgeted spould budgeted spould be spent only spent S11,000, there is a 9000 surplus. If the \$9,000 remained in the athletics department's or team's budget, you should include the \$9,000 in your reported revenues. If, however, the \$9,000 was taken out of the athletics department's or team's budget, do not include the \$9,000 in your reported revenues.


