During foodborne illness outbreak investigations, environmental health specialists collect detailed environmental data by conducting environmental assessments. These data identify how and why the food became contaminated with pathogens, and how and why these pathogens were not eliminated before ingestion. When reported to CDC via NEARS, this information provides an opportunity

to systematically monitor and evaluate environmental factors, which can then be used to develop effective foodborne illness

outbreak response and preventative controls.

Data from foodborne outbreak environmental assessments are collected by environmental health professionals responding to foodborne outbreaks at retail food establishments. Data are collected through direct observations at the establishment, and through manager interviews or pen-and-paper at the establishment. Participating food safety programs then enter their data into a secured

The information collected through NEARS is primarily used by the CDC to identify and understand environmental factors
