**PURPOSE:** The *Understanding Post Adoption and Guardianship Instability for Children and Youth Who Exit Foster Care* (PAGI) project Toolkit resources are intended to help state child welfare agencies develop more systematic data systems to track instability outcomes in children who exit foster care to adoption or guardianship.
