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Report Your Fish

All **bluefin tuna** landings and dead discards, and **swordfish** and **billfish** (white and blue marlin, sailfish, and roundscale spearfish) landings must be reported to NOAA Fisheries within 24 hours of the vessel returning from the trip.

Maryland and North Carolina vessel owners should report their **recreational** bluefin tuna, blue marlin, white marlin, roundscale spearfish, sailfish and swordfish landings at state-operated reporting stations and not through this system.
