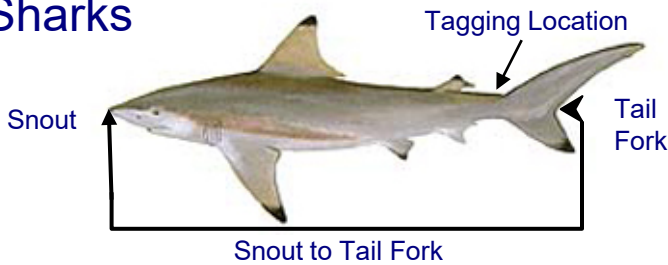

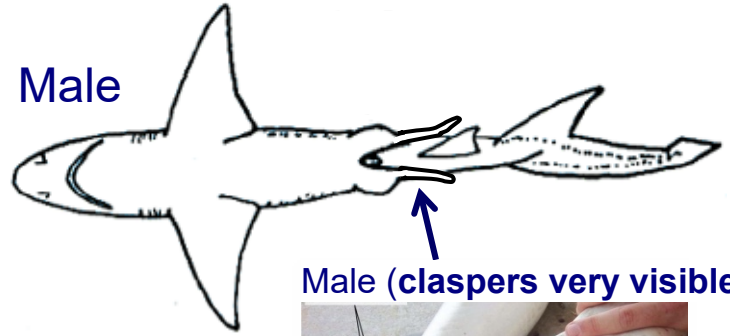

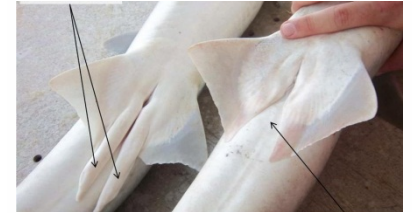


HOW TO DETERMINE SEX OF SHARKS

Male

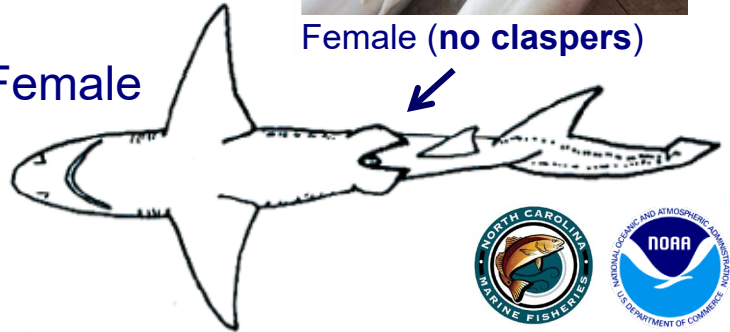


Male (claspers very visible)
